

1. YoungHoon Kim, IQ 276

As of 2024, YoungHoon Kim established the Official World Record® for the title "The World's Highest IQ Person Now" with IQ 276 at the only world record certification body accredited by the Council of the Notariats of the European Union, and his world record was firstly inducted into the Hall of Fame of the Official World Record®. YoungHoon Kim's IQ accreditation is from the World Mind Sports Council, World Memory Championships, World Speed Reading Championships, World Mind Mapping Championships, GIGA Society, Supertalent World Record & Supertalent of the World, Korea Masterpiece & Master Certification Committee, Challenge Korea Headquarters, Korea Best Record Institute, Korea Record Institute, World Genius Directory, Global Genius Registry, Esoteriq Society, Ultima Society & Nano Society. With perfect scores on various clinical and experimental high range intelligence tests, YoungHoon Kim's high IQ scores were verified by the

GIGA Society (1/billion), Yale Clinical Neuroscientist PhD (1/10 million), Olympiq Society (1/3 million), Mega Society (1/million), Triple Nine Society (1/1000), and Mensa (1/50). In 2024, Prof. YoungHoon Kim was named as number one with the world's highest IQ by Reader's Digest, The Economist, CNN, CNBC, etc., and he was recognized and interviewed as a South Korean with the world's highest IQ by Arirang TV of South Korea Ministry of Culture. His achievements span various fields, including psychology, neuroscience, linguistics, counseling, coaching, sociology, philosophy, and theology. Serving as Tony Buzan Honorary Professor in Creative Thinking at Tony Buzan Academy and University; Honorary Council Member at the World Mind Sports Council and World Memory Championships, YoungHoon Kim founded a non-profit organization, the United Sigma Intelligence Association (USIA) for the world's brightest minds, which includes seven Nobel Prize winners and the greatest minds in the world such as Noam Chomsky, Steven Pinker, Yuval Harari, Richard Dawkins, Howard Gardner, Neil deGrasse Tyson, Daniel Dennett, Anthony Giddens, Philip Zimbardo, and Terence Tao. Through the USIA, He also founded the Intellectual Hall of Fame with support of Lifeboat Foundation, honorably inducted Elon Musk, Jeff Bezos, Bill Gates, Warren Buffett, and Stephen Hawking. YoungHoon Kim has contributed to society and humanity as Co-President and Vice-Chairman of the Board at an NGO Challenge Korea Headquarters where top South Korean leaders including 8th UN General-Secretary, 12th President of the World Bank Group, Chairman of UN IPCC, Mayor of Seoul Metropolitan Government, President of South Korea National Assembly, and South Korea Government Ministers were awarded the Challenge Korea Grand Prize. YoungHoon Kim is also Honorary Chairman of Judging Committee for South Korea National Assembly Standing Committee Chairman Award & South Korea Seoul Metropolitan Government Mayor Award. In recognition of significant contributions to the field of cognitive science, Prof. YoungHoon Kim was

awarded an Honorary Doctor of Science in Cognitive Science degree from the American Management University (AMU); Honorary Doctorate from the City University of Paris, establishing the world record title "The First and Youngest Honorary Doctor of Science in Cognitive Science in the World" at the Supertalent World Record and Korea Best Record Institute. In addition, YoungHoon Kim was appointed Honorary Professor in Strategic Thinking and Leadership at the American Management University(AMU). (updated on September 2024)

2. Terence Tao, IQ 230

Terence Tao is an Australian-American mathematician known for his groundbreaking work in harmonic analysis, partial differential equations,

and additive combinatorics. Demonstrating extraordinary mathematical abilities from a young age, he earned his Ph.D. from Princeton University at just 20 and became a full professor at UCLA by 24. He received the prestigious Fields Medal in 2006 for his contributions to multiple areas of mathematics, cementing his status as one of the leading mathematicians of his generation. Tao is celebrated not only for his individual achievements but also for his collaborative spirit, having worked with numerous other mathematicians to solve complex problems. Additionally, his prolific writing includes both research papers and books, making advanced mathematical concepts more accessible to a broader audience

3. Marilyn Vos Savant, IQ 228

Marilyn vos Savant is an American author, columnist, and public figure known for her high IQ, which is listed in the Guinness Book of World Records. She gained widespread recognition for her "Ask Marilyn" column in Parade magazine, where she answers readers' questions on a variety of topics ranging from puzzles to philosophy. Vos Savant's intelligence has sparked both admiration and controversy, with some questioning the validity of IQ

tests and the nature of intelligence itself. Despite this, she remains a respected figure in the field of cognitive science, contributing insights on critical thinking and problem-solving. 4. Christopher Hirata, IQ 225

Christopher Hirata is a Japanese-American astrophysicist known for his extraordinary mathematical abilities, which led him to become the youngest American to win a gold medal at the International Physics Olympiad at the age of 13. He enrolled at California Institute of Technology (Caltech) at 14 and earned his Ph.D. in astrophysics from Princeton University by the age of 22. Hirata's research focuses on cosmology, gravitational lensing, and dark

energy, contributing significantly to our understanding of the universe's structure and evolution. He has been recognized with prestigious awards, including the MacArthur Fellowship, for his groundbreaking work in theoretical astrophysics. Hirata continues to inspire young scientists through his research, mentorship, and dedication to unraveling the mysteries of the cosmos.

5. Sho Yano, IQ 200

Sho Yano is a remarkable individual recognized for his exceptional intellect and achievements. He gained widespread attention for graduating from the University of Chicago at the age of 12, becoming the youngest student to earn a bachelor's degree from the institution. 6. Evangelos Katsioulis, IQ 198

Evangelos Katsioulis is a Greek psychiatrist and high IQ society member, known for his exceptional intelligence and achievements. He holds several degrees, including a medical degree, a master's degree in medical research methodology, and a master's degree in philosophy. 7. Christopher Harding, IQ 197

1966 to 1988 under the category "Smartest Man in the World" with an IQ score in the range of 196–197. His ISPE, founded in 1974, requires its members to score at or above the 99.9th percentile on standardized intelligence tests, highlighting its exclusivity and the high intellectual caliber of its members.

8. Christopher Langan, IQ 195

Christopher Langan is widely known for having one of the highest recorded IQ scores in the world, reportedly around 195. He gained public attention due to his remarkable intellect, often referred to as a "self-educated autodidact" despite having a difficult childhood and lacking formal higher education. Langan has worked in various jobs, including as a construction worker, forest ranger, and cowboy. He developed the "Cognitive-Theoretic Model of the Universe" (CTMU), a theory attempting to unify science, philosophy, and theology. Despite his brilliance, Langan's life story is complex, marked by personal struggles and controversies, adding depth to his enigmatic persona.

9. Rick Rosner, IQ 192
